This year was a hard year to say the least with COVID-19 gripping the world. Collecting donations for the Tee Times 4 Turf auction was largely successful and the vast majority of clubs who donated in the past continued their donations in 2020. While donations remained strong, the board of directors decided to delay the auction because of all the uncertainty with the pandemic, and possible restrictions to golf for the 2020 season. The auction that was originally planned for the first two weeks in May was held the first week of August. The clear drawback to holding the auction in August was the reduction of time that winning bidders had to use the certificates, but one that was unavoidable.
